

PERT

Postsecondary Education Readiness Test

This test determines if a student is “college ready”, which indicates they will not need remedial classes when they start taking classes in college.

All students will take the PERT in their junior year of high school (spring semester) if they do not have a qualifying ACT or SAT score on file with Lyman High School. The qualifying concordant scores for ACT and SAT are as follows:

	Math	Reading	Writing
SAT	440	440	Reading score counts for both
ACT	19	18	17
PERT	113	104	99

If a student does not make a qualifying score on either the SAT, ACT or PERT they will be placed in the Math for College readiness and/or English for College readiness classes for their senior year of high school. (Qualifying scores subject to change by the State of Florida at anytime.)
