

Lyman High School Student Registration Checklist

Follow the Steps below and scan the QR codes for more information.

•	Step 1: Review your graduation requirements in Skyward	QR code
	Login to your Skyward account. Click on the Graduation Requirements tab. Pay close attention to the Remaining column (in red). This will show you any courses that you still need to take. Remember that you will need to complete 4 Math courses while in high school (Math courses taken in middle school will be recorded in the elective credit category).	
•	Step 2: Review your preloaded courses in Skyward	QR code
	Core Academic and some elective courses have been pre-loaded in Skyward for you based on prior coursework, grades and test scores. Please discuss your coursework with your parents, teachers and/or counselor. If needed, please see Ms. Hickey in the Student Services office to schedule an appointment with your counselor between Feb. 13 - 26.	
•	Step 3: If needed, complete the Class Change/Override Form	QR code
	After speaking with your parent, teacher, or counselor you would like a different course than has been preloaded for you, please complete the Class Change/Override Form.	
•	Step 4: Review Curriculum Guide	QR code
	Review the Curriculum Guide to Select electives and alternate options. Please make sure you pay attention to course prerequisites and read all course descriptions so you understand what each class entails.	
•	<u>Step 5</u> : Enter electives and alternates in Skyward	QR code
	You will need 7.0 total credits (not just 7 courses!) and 3.0 credits of alternate courses. Once you have selected your electives and alternates, enter the courses into Skyward. Scan the QR code to follow the directions to enter in your courses.	
•	Step 6: Complete applications for courses that require one	QR code
	Some courses require the completion of an application. The QR code will link you to applications for Latinos in Action, Young Women and Young Men of Excellence, PIT Crew, a Virtual Class and/or an Off-Campus Study Hall period.	

Registration Reminders

- ✓ Select **7.0 TOTAL credits under** "Request Courses", and **3.0 credits under** "Alternate Courses" ✓ Select 7.0 Total credits FIRST, **THEN** select Alternates
- ✓ Foreign Language is not required to graduate, but 2 years is required for Bright Futures eligibility

✓ Some CTE Academies can only be started in certain grade levels (see chart below)
