Advanced Placement Test Performance

2021-2022 Data



Lyman High School administered 1195 Advanced Placement exams in 28 courses (at no cost to students). The most popular AP courses are World History, US History, English Language and Composition, US Government and Politics, and Macroeconomics.

LHS had an average pass rate of 61% on AP exams. For comparison, the Florida pass rate was 51%, and the national pass rate was 57%.

All juniors and seniors at LHS get an opportunity to take the SAT at no cost.

The average Lyman High School SAT score is 1001 out of 1600, higher than the Florida average of 983.

LHS students in 9-11th grade have an opportunity to take the PSAT at no cost.



LHS 10th graders had an average PSAT score of 924 out of 1520, higher than the Florida average of 890.

College Acceleration and Workforce Readiness

65% of LHS students take some form of acceleration (college-level classes or industry certifications).

LHS also offers 22 industry certifications. Some of the most popular ones are Autodesk Certified User - Inventor and Certified Food Safety Manager. In total, students earned 481 industry certifications.

Lyman High School had a 97% graduation rate for the Class of 2021.

LHS had over 460 Bright Futures recipients, totalling over \$4,632,817 in scholarships.

Lyman High School earned a B grade from the Florida DOE in 2022.

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- LHS has a total enrollment of 2,200 students across grades 9-12.
- The Academy of Engineering is Lyman's top rated Magnet Program, named a School of Distinction by Magnet Schools of America.
- LHS is home to the Civic Engagement and Innovation Lab (CEIL), a concept where students work collaboratively to solve real-world problems.
- LHS offers 10 Career and Technical Education (CTE) Academies where students can earn Industry Certifications.
- Lyman is home to award winning art programs, including Band, Chorus, Drama, Dance, 2D/3D Art, AP Art History, and AP Music Theory.
- Lyman students "Get Involved" through participation in the 32 athletic teams and over 60 clubs and organizations.
- LHS awards qualified students the prestigious AP Capstone Diploma, offering 29 Advanced Placement (AP) course options in 9th-12th grade.
